- Darighe Proprietor's Blend '02 (Columbia Valley)** 75
40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% Merlot, 12% Cabernet Franc, 14% Malbec & 7% Petit Verdot. Bouquet of black fruits, flowers & subtly spicy oak. Fleshy palate
- Alexander Valley Vineyards "Cyrus" '04 (Alexander Valley, California)** 80
Blend of 68% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc & 2% Malbec. Aromas of black cherry, dark chocolate with rich plum & blueberry on the palate
- Failla "Phoenix Ranch" Syrah '07 (Napa)** 85
Coffee, bright fruit & some floral components on the nose. The palate is just as interesting, with ripe blueberry & coffee
- Ken Wright Cellars "Abbot Claim Vineyards" Pinot Noir '07 (Willamette Valley)** 90
Scorched earth, smoke, blueberry, & blackberry liqueur matched by sweet black fruit
- Molly Dooker "Blue Eyed Boy" Shiraz '07 (McClaren Vale, Australia)**

A Blueberry monster with candied plum & white pepper on the palate
- Hourglass "Blueline" Merlot '07 (Napa)** 125
Pretty notes of coffee, mocha, herbs & chocolate intertwined with lush berry fruit
- Sanguis "As the Crow Flies" '06 (Santa Ynez Valley, California)** 130
Mostly Syrah with about 3% Viognier. The wine has a floral, sexy bouquet with plenty of sweet cassis & smoked meats. A little bit of kirsch as well
- Sanguis "The Optimist" '05 (Santa Ynez Valley, California)** 130
100% Syrah. Sweet bouquet of blackberries, smoke, espresso roast, chocolate, & earth. Full-bodied, opulent & voluptuous with a long, heady finish
- Sanguis "Novillero" '06 (Santa Ynez Valley, California)** 130
Blend of 96% Syrah, 3% Grenache, & 1% Viognier. Spicy, meaty aromatics, which also include creme de cassis, blackberry, licorice, & earth. It is a powerful wine, layered & extravagantly rich

- Lewis Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon '06 (Napa)** 130
Powerful, ripe, fleshy. Rich, intense smoky currant, blackberry & black cherry fruit
- Bergström Vineyard Pinot Noir '06 (Willamette Valley, Oregon)** 140
Josh Bergström shows why he is one of the finest producers with his Bergström Estate Pinot. Fruit shows power yet elegance. Aromatic nose, velvety texture & impressive finish
- Beaux Freres "The Upper Terrace" Pinot Noir '06 (Willamette Valley, Or.)** 150
Elegant & refined, with a plush underpinning to the luscious raspberry, blackberry & black plum fruit, shaded with subtle hints of peppermint & a whiff of char as the finish sails on smoothly
- Conterno-Fantino Barolo Vigna Del Gris '04 (Piedmont, Italy)** 150
100% Nebbiolo. Enticing floral, truffle & minerality on the nose, with wild red fruits, mocha & smoky oak on the palate
- Ramey Jericho Canyon Vineyard '04 (Napa)** 175
76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc. Wonderfully sweet nose of espresso roast, fudge, blackberry, & cassis with a hint of incense & smoke
- Revana Cabernet Sauvignon '05 (St. Helena, Napa)** 180
Heidi Barrett heads up the wine making and it shows in the texture alone. Aromas of black cherry, cocoa powder & toast. Fruit is rich cherry & reflects the aromas
- Sea Smoke "Ten" Pinot Noir '08 (Sta. Rita Hills, Santa Barbara)** 190
Intense, ripe & vibrant, exhibiting a mix of blueberry, black cherry, spice & a Rocky minerality. Elegant & balanced
- Pahlmeyer Proprietary '04 (Napa)** 225
Blend of 79% Cabernet Sauvignon, 11% Merlot, & the rest Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, & Malbec. Possesses notes of vanilla, espresso roast, black currants, plums, & licorice
- Angelou Gaja Barbaresco '05 (Piedmont, Italy)** 225
Floral aromatics give way to brightly spiced red fruits, menthol & licorice
- Ovid Red Wine '06 (Napa)** 250
Made by one of the biggest names in the business, Andy Erickson, the wine maker for the cult wine Screaming Eagle. 43% Cabernet Sauvignon, 41% Cabernet Franc & the rest Merlot and Petite Verdot. The wine is velvety & deep with hints of cassis, licorice, coffee & tobacco
- Shafer Hillside Select Cabernet Sauvignon '06 (Stag's Leap District, Napa)** 375
Reveals beautiful aromas and flavors of grilled meats and herbs intertwined with extravagant amounts of blackberry and cassis fruit, licorice, and charcoal
